Manager will be responsible for administrative, operating and management duties associated with the Animas-La Plata Project facilities located in Durango, Colorado. The manager will be hired and supervised by the Management Committee of the Association. This position will be considered an exempt position with a salary range of \$80,000 - \$110,000. The Association has entered into an O&M Transfer Agreement with the United States Bureau of Reclamation, the owner of the project. The Association members include: the Southern Ute Indian Tribe, the Ute Mountain Ute Indian Tribe, the San Juan Water Commission, the La Plata Water Conservancy District (NM) and the Colorado Water Resources and Power Development Authority, and the Navajo Nation (NM).

The primary duty of the manager is the oversight of the general operation and maintenance of Ridges Basin Dam, Inlet Conduit and Pumping Plant, including but not limited to regulating releases, administering pumping regimes and accounting of project releases for each sponsor. Additional duties include the establishment of an efficient pumping schedule based on water availability and power costs; development/management of comprehensive program policies and procedures related to maintenance of ALP project equipment and related facilities; preparation and administration of budgets including collection of revenues; and manages the development, implementation and evaluation of work plans, policies and procedures to achieve annual goals/objectives. Applicants should have knowledge of operation and maintenance of Bureau of Reclamation structures and facilities and knowledge of Standard Operating Procedures associated with pumping plants or water regulating facilities.

Qualifications require a 4-year degree with a major in engineering, public or business administration, water resource management or a closely related field; 5 years of experience in management and operation of a complex, high capacity water transmission and/or water storage facility; and 5 years of supervisory experience.
